Steve ErkenBrack has worked as an attorney in both the private and public sectors for more than 25 years. He is currently Rocky Mountain Health Plans' Vice-President for Legal Affairs.

From 1993 to 1997, Steve served as Colorado's Chief Deputy Attorney General, the #2 person in the Department of Law for Gale Norton, supervising the 170 attorneys who provided legal representation for every state agency in Colorado.

From 1987 to 1993, Steve served as the District Attorney for Mesa County, winning three elections. In 1993, he was unanimously selected by all elected DAs in Colorado to serve as President of the Colorado District Attorneys Council.

Both before his election as DA, and after his service as Chief Deputy Attorney General, Steve worked as a trial attorney in Grand Junction, with an emphasis in business litigation.

Steve presently serves on the Business Council for Healthcare Competition for the Colorado Association of Commerce & Industry, the Board of Directors for the Colorado Civil Justice League, the Board of Directors for Mesa County Partners, and the Health Care Subcommittee for Club 20, through which he is working to build a network of all 58 non-metropolitan counties in the state to address rural health care issues. In the past, Steve has served on the Colorado Board of Law Examiners (Chairman), the Colorado District Attorneys Council (President), and the Board of Governors of the Colorado Bar Association.

Since 1979, Steve has been happily married to Lysa, who is both a R.N. and a Pediatric Nurse Practitioner. Steve and Lysa have three adult children: Kabe, Liz, and Dan.
