STATE SCHOOL LANDS, AGRICULTURAL LEASES ON

WHEREAS: The adoption of Colorado's new constitutional provisions governing state trust lands has created the need for legislation to implement the new procedures, and

WHEREAS: Legislation for that purpose has been introduced by Senator Dave Wattenberg, in the form of Senate Bill 97-49, and

WHEREAS: One important question with which the legislation must deal is the long-term stability of existing agricultural leases on state trust lands, and

WHEREAS: The Colorado Cattlemen have worked with Senator Bishop on language which will help ensure stability for existing leases,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors at its 45th Annual Meeting March 7, 1997 that CLUB 20 supports the Cattlemen's Association's proposal to implement the new State Land Board procedures while also guaranteeing the stability of agricultural leases.
