Interstate 70 Corridor Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS)

WHEREAS CLUB 20 was founded to improve the transportation system in Western Colorado;
and

WHEREAS CLUB 20 realizes the importance of both the Interstate Highway system and the State Highway system to the Statewide Transportation system; and

WHEREAS CLUB 20 supports a seamless multi-modal transportation system; and

WHEREAS several transportation study and planning efforts are underway, including the Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS) for Interstate 70 from Denver to Glenwood Springs; and

WHEREAS the Mountain Corridor Advisory Committee (MCAC) was established to advise CDOT and FHWA on the development of the PEIS and CLUB 20 was invited to participate;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that CLUB 20 supports the process for developing the Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS) for the I-70 Corridor keeping in mind:

- The importance of a multi-modal approach,
- The importance of connectivity to Denver International Airport,
- The importance of alternative routes to I-70,
- The importance of scientific basis and data for conclusions and recommendations
- That adequate opportunity is available for public review and comment of findings
- That the PEIS study is expedited; and
- That all options evaluated during the study be retained and incorporated in the findings and future I-70 planning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that CLUB 20 appreciates the work of the Mountain Corridor Advisory Committee, the Colorado Department of Transportation, and J.F. Sato & Associates in the development of the Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement.
